DIPSITE ROUND-UP

Over the years, dipsites have added a new dimension of glory to their alma mater. There exists today a new vital consciousness of DPS—Dipsite relationship that keeps the school flag flying gloriously in all spheres of national living : social, cultural, academic and financial.

There are such brilliant dipsites like Vinod Sundra, an inventor at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology in the States, and Professor Subramaniam Swamy, the youngest-ever Professor of Economics at Harvard University, and Dr Vinod Sena, Reader at Delhi University. A number of dipsites are in the country's top managerial and administrative cadres : among those in the I.F.S. and I.A.S. are Arun Bannerjea, Shashi Uban, Udipto Ghosh and his brother Sudipto, Ajoy Sinha, Jagdish Khattar and Inderjit Chowdhary, while H.V. Krishnamurthy is Managing Director, at 30, of the 7-crore project, The Punjab Film and News Corporation. Dipsites have made their mark in the celluloid world, too, with outstanding artistes such as Kabir Bedi, Vinod Khanna and Navin and Pravin Nischal.

Devendra Kumar is the youngest-ever Vice-President of the Delhi University Teachers Association and Salman Khurshid is an outstanding writer, theatre artist and TV personality; Anoop Bose is among the best debators of the University.

Miss Nimmi Gulati stood third in the University last year in B.Sc Hons in Botany, and Miss Bindu Nagpal and Ravina Chadha stood first in the University in B.Sc Hons and in M. Sc. in Home Science. Sushil Ansal has earned the reputation of being 'India's Skyscraper Maker' and has constructed many of the multi-storeyed structures in the Connaught Circus-Curzon Road complex.

There are prominent dipsite journalists as Vijay Shanker, Ramu Sharma, Arun Khanna, and Gautam Shiveshwarker while Narendra Aggarwal is perhaps the youngest-ever Financial Correspondent of a prominent daily.

Vinay Seth, I. K. Nanda, Sripad Bhalerao and Vikram Dutt are well-known names in Delhi basketball, both as excellent State-level players and as organisers.

There are a number of prominent dipsite engineers such as Arun Kochar and Ram Bhargava and dynamic young architects like Arun Virmani and Ajit Dighe, and Chartered Accountants like Prakash Talreja and Anil Gupta and Bimal Raizada.

Mr Vivek Bhaskar is M. S. in Ceramic Technology from the United States and is Managing Director of A. N. Bhaskar Sons, while Subodh Jain is the Senior Director of

Vraj Lal Mani Ram and Sons, which is a huge cigarette-manufacturing firm; Anil Gandhi is Director of Havells Electricals Ltd and Arun Goyle is Director of Essex Farms Pvt Ltd. Shrikant and Chanderkant Jain are Directors of B. K. Plastics Pvt Ltd Mohinder Kapur is Director of a top national press, Goverdhan Kapur Sons. The Jaipuria brothers and the Sood brothers are eminent industrialists and Chander Mohan Chadha is Director of the chain of Atma Ram Chadha establishments. Naresh Khanna is a senior officer in IBM, and Ramesh Vaswani holds an important position in DCM.

Deepak Vadhera was India's Table-Tennis Number One in 1971-72, and Pankaj Butalia is Delhi's Table-Tennis Number One. Shashi Gujral taught Literature at the East-West Centre in Hawaii. Her sister Indu Gujral obtained a diploma in Chinese Language from Hong Kong University and is now a Lecturer in the Department of Chinese Studies in Delhi University. Sunaina Rao is a first class M. A. in Psychology from Delhi University and has gone for higher studies to Connecticut on a government scholarship. Her brother Vishwanath Rao is Asst Manager of Oberoi Sheraton in Bombay. C. K. Kanai is an engineer and the only Indian student selected for the graduate programme at the Graduate School of Management, Vanderbilt University, U. S. Sunil Garg is engaged in the Master's and Ph. D programmes in Polynie Chemis-

try at Stevens Institute of Technology, Hoboken, U. S. A. Sharad Ajit Jain came third in the Pre-Medical Examination of Mysore University. The late Amala Chatterjee got a first class in M. A. History from Delhi University in 1972-73.

Bharat Inder Singh is in Poona's Armed Forces Medical College. He recently bagged 19 medals in the Poona and Maharashtra Universities Athletics Meet. Anil Malik is in Hamburg Nordmark Wuffing Division of German Remedies Pvt Ltd and is in charge of Sales in Haryana State.

There are countless dipsite army and air force officers. In one particular army unit on the border, all the four senior officers are dipsites. Dipsites have also died fighting for their country, among whom are Captain Verinder Sachar and 2nd Lieut Satish Jaswal who have been awarded Vir Chakras.

The membership has almost doubled in 1973 and dipsites are owning up the school more than ever before.

The Dipsites Association has instituted a Careers Bureau, to assist dipsites in their careers, and a registered newsletter THE DIPSITES. They are working for the construction of THE DIPSITES-MUKESH BHANDARI PAVILION which will house their LOUNGE and OFFICE and which will be the property of the Delhi Public School Society.

LETTERS

Dear Sir

I am sorry I could not write to you for all these months. Till about a week ago I was in Bombay doing Inter Science in St Xavier's College. I was studying in Group 'B' so as to study Medicine. I had also applied for the U.S.S.R. Government scholarship. I got this scholarship this month.

I was told that I had to come here immediately. I wanted to come to Delhi and say good-bye to my dearest and oldest friends. But I could not do so.

I came to Kiev on the 11th of this month. The Russians take great medical care of all the people in the country. I was therefore to undergo a medical examination the day I came here. I was told that I would be free for a few days to get acclimatized. I have been going around the city with a few friends. This city is so small there is no question of getting lost here.

Kiev is the capital of the Ukraine Soviet Socialist Republic. It is supposed to be the most beautiful city in USSR. There are many parks here. They all have a natural beauty unlike other parks. One of the parks is on the hill which overlooks the River Dneiper. It is one of the biggest parks in Kiev. There is hardly any traffic there and therefore there is peace and quiet. This place is a site for old people for their daily walk, a playground for children and a good place for forgetting one's worries.

The city being very small there is only one Metro (underground railway) line. This runs through the centre of the city. This underground railway runs about a hundred

metres under the ground. These underground systems are also precautionary measures for the safety of people in case of war.

The city is still under development. It is extending across the Dneiper River. That is the new part of the city.

In the centre of the city is a museum called the Lenin Museum. In this museum everything concerning the life of Lenin is shown. There are letters written by Lenin, books written by Karl Marx, Engels and Lenin. There are also copies of the newspaper edited by Lenin. That was the first Russian newspaper and was called Pravda (Truth).

I intend going round the city and seeing every detail in it.

The school continues to receive VIPs. Those who visited us during the year are Mrs Indira Gandhi, Mr Jagjivan Ram, Gen Chaudhri, Dr G S Dhillon, Mr Shah Nawaz Khan, Mr M B Raina, Mr KPS Menon. Their words of encouragement have been a source of great strength to the school community.

Delhi Public School R.K. Puram has already made a good impression on the public of Delhi and their exhibition which I had the privilege of inaugurating on 28 August 73 indicated that a lot of creative work is being done there in addition to academic studies. The school has also a good music orchestra. Dipsites are invited to visit their school in R.K. Puram whenever they pass that way.

DOWN MEMORY LANE

(extract from the School Bulletin of
30 November 1959)

A Dipsite Becomes An Inventor

We are fully aware of the fact that inventing new devices and making them commercially profitable is not an easy matter. An old student of the Delhi Public School, Vinod Sundra gave details of his invention at a Boston Electronics show and demonstrated its working. This bit of news was

given in The Hindustan Times and came straight from Boston.

Mr Sundra found that a good deal of time was wasted ringing up numbers that were always engaged. This led him to develop a mechanism which keeps ringing a telephone number without any manual operation, until the line becomes disengaged. This mechanical device prevents any other caller from getting in ahead and when the call is answered the device automatically rings a buzzer at the caller's end so that he can pick up his own telephone and begin his conversation.

This invention has gained Vinod Sundra the Bachelor of Science degree in Electrical Engineering at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology.

He has also developed a drum-like instrument into which several telephone numbers could be inserted, and when a button was touched the instrument rang a selected number. Mr Sundra has taken out patents on the inventions and believes that businessmen will be greatly benefited by them.

Vinod Sundra joined Std VI in Delhi Public in 1950. He passed his Senior Cambridge in 1953 with a Second Division. His younger brother Pramod Sundra passed the Senior Cambridge in 1956.

Mr Sham Sundra, their father, was the Managing Director of Electronics Ltd, New Delhi. A few years ago he presented the school with a tape-recorder. We do hope that Mr Sundra will make the school a lovely gift to celebrate this rather great and important occasion. It is not everyday that a father finds his son becoming an inventor. We do feel rather proud of this son of the School !

A DIPSITE V.I.P. SPEAKS

extract from **SCREEN** interview of 19 October 1973

In the interview with "Screen" which Mr H. V. Krishnamurthy, Managing Director of The Punjab Film and News Corporation, gave in Madras recently, he not only spelt out the twin objectives of the Plan, which were to carry the medium of the film to rural areas of Punjab and to revive the once flourishing Punjab film industry, but also declared that the top priority in plan implementation will be given to the construction of two hundred cinemas.

ON RIVER BANK

The earnestness of the Punjab Government in implementing its plan for its film industry is evident in the fact that work on twentyfive permanent theatres in sub-divisional headquarters and forty semi-permanent ones in community block development headquarters has already been taken up this month and is expected to be completed in about a year and a half.

As these theatres get completed and as more in the target are taken up in various other centres needing exhibition facilities, a well equipped film studio and an institution to train technicians and artistes will be built on a hundred-acre plot, which is being acquired on the banks of the river Sutlej. The facilities to be provided by the studio include mobile equipment needed for location shooting.

Incentives for film-making like financial assistance on the lines of the Film Finance

Corporation is also a part of the thoughtfully worked out plan outlay of rupees seven crores and odd. Bombay film notables B. R. Chopra, Ramanand Sagar, Dara Singh, Prem Dhawan, all of whom hail from Punjab and Subodh Mukherji, a Bengali, are on the Board of Directors of P. F. N. C.

CORRECT STEPS

Mr Krishnamurthy said that there was no intention on the part of the Punjab Government to pull back talent to the region, meaning those who migrated to Bombay after partition and prospered in their respective fields.

There is no need to as there is enough untapped talent left in Punjab as also in other regions of the country. What the regional film industries need most to develop and flourish are adequate exhibition facilities and reasonable incentives. The inadequate number of cinema houses for a growing population most of which were concentrated in cities and big towns, inevitably came under the sway of commercially potential Hindi films. With their business potential increasingly dwindling the regional cinemas received setbacks. The Punjab Government has taken the correct step towards reviving the once flourishing Punjabi film industry, which should go a long way in bringing entertainment and enlightenment to the bulk of the State's population, the rural folk. ●

AMALA CHATTERJEE (Died 20 July 1973)
